## MONEY MATTERS

**Financial highlights** for fiscal 2010, through August:

1. Offering collections are about 7% over last year for the first two months of the fiscal year
2. Projected tuition receipts are \$100,000 below the budgeted amount due to less than anticipated enrollment
3. Expenses are on par with the budgeted amounts
4. Based on the above, the projected deficit for the current fiscal year (ending 06/30/10) is \$80,000
5. To fund any year-end deficit, restricted funds will need to be drawn down

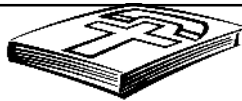
